The County of Wellington is seeking one volunteer from the community of Mapleton Township, to join the Accessibility Advisory Committee. The community member must be actively involved with organizations for people with disabilities, is a caregiver for people with disabilities or is a person with a disability.

The Accessibility Advisory Committee meets 4 times a year and will compensate for mileage and per diem.

The main purpose and activities of the Accessibility Advisory Committee is to:

- Advise Council on the preparation, implementation and effectiveness of its annual accessibility plan.
- Advise Council on other accessibility related issues within the County.

Applicants must reside in Mapleton Township; be over the age of 18 years; and as per the Ontarians with Disabilities Act, a majority of the committee members will include people with disabilities.
