Thank you for your June 28, 2019, letter to the Environmental Assessment and Permissions Branch regarding the Badley (Metcalf Street) Bridge Replacement/Rehabilitation, Victoria Street Pedestrian Bridge and West Mill Street Enhancements (Projects) as proposed by the County of Wellington and the Township of Centre Wellington (Proponents) and the conditions placed on the Project by the Minister of the Environment, Conservation and Parks.

In your letter you indicated that the County of Wellington (County) has satisfied the conditions in the following ways:


- The County posted the final design of the Badley (Metcalf Street) Bridge, alongside a mention indicating that two bike lanes were included in the final design, on their website;
- The County incorporated design details, proposed in the Heritage Impact Assessment, in the final design of the Badley (Metcalf Street) Bridge to commemorate the existing Badley (Metcalf Street) Bridge and to be sympathetic to surrounding cultural heritage resources;
- The County submitted the Supplementary Heritage Impact Assessment to the Ministry of Tourism, Culture and Sport, who confirmed that they were satisfied with the amended assessment;
- The County held a public meeting on June 13, 2019, to inform the public of the proposed design for the Badley (Metcalf Street) Bridge; and
- The County submitted the final design of the Badley (Metcalf Street) Bridge, the rationale behind the bridge and the documentation of the Public Information Centre held on June 13, 2019, to the Ministry of Environment, Conservation and Parks.

Based on this information, alongside the information received in your previous letters, the Environmental Assessment and Permissions Branch is satisfied that the Proponent has complied with the conditions outlined in the Minister's decision dated August 25, 2019, in accordance with the Environmental Assessment Act.
