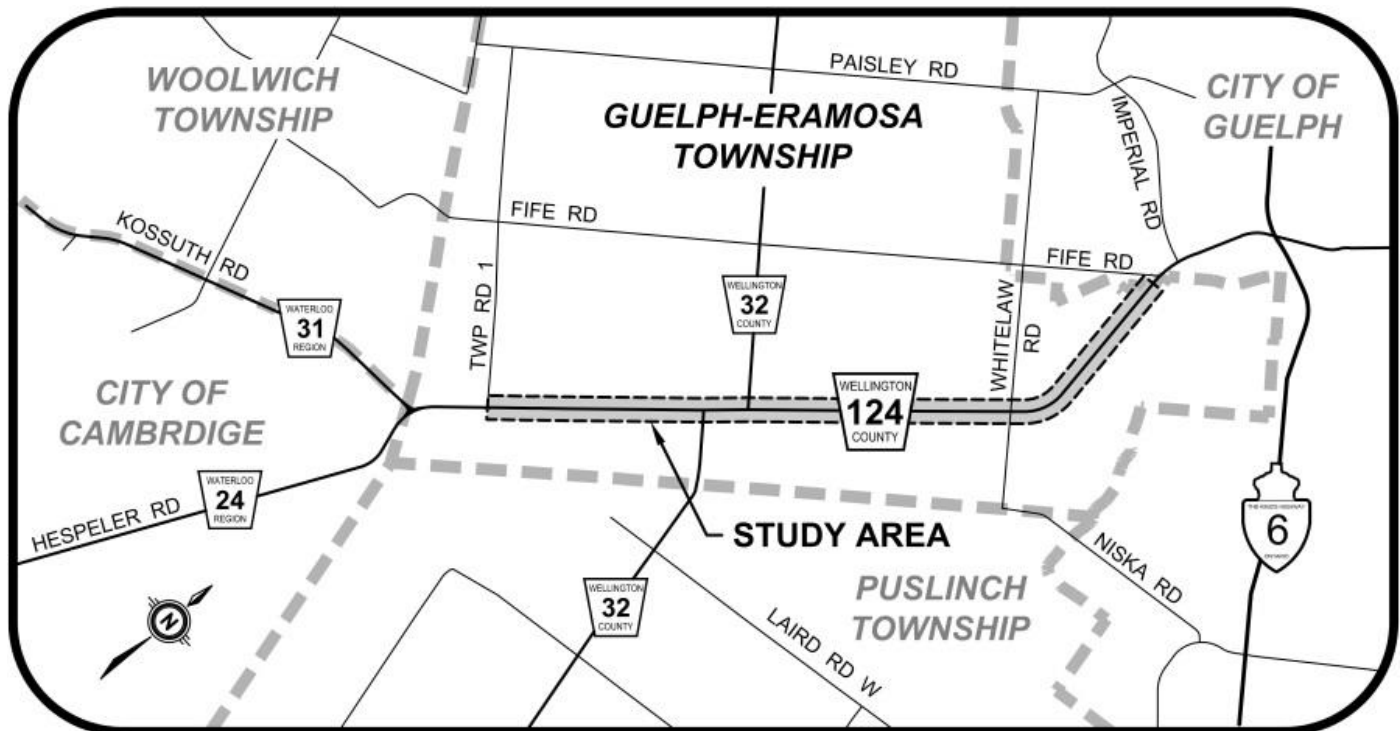

Wellington Road 124
Guelph-Eramosa Township Road 1 to Fife Road Study
Guelph-Eramosa Township
Schedule 'C' Municipal Class Environmental Assessment**

The County of Wellington has undertaken a study following the approved process for Schedule 'C' projects under the "Municipal Class Environmental Assessment" to address improvements to Wellington Road (WR) 124 between Township Road 1 and Fife Road.



The Recommended Design Alternative includes the following key elements:

- Two roundabouts – one at WR 124 and WR 32N, and one at WR 124 and WR 32S;
- Four lanes between the two roundabouts, with a centre median
- Three lanes
 - between the rail crossing and the WR 32S roundabout,
 - between the WR32N roundabout and Whitelaw Road, and
 - between Fife Road and 350m west of Fife Road
- Two lanes for the remainder of the road with lane modifications at other intersections

By this Notice, the Environmental Study Report is being placed on the public record until January 31, 2020 for a 50-day review period in accordance with the requirements of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (minimum 30-day review period required). Subject to comments received as a result of this Notice, and receipt of necessary approvals, the project may proceed to construction.

If concerns regarding this project cannot be resolved in discussion with the County of Wellington, a person or party may request that the Minister of Environment, Conservation and Parks make an order for the project to comply with Part II of the Environmental Assessment Act (referred to as a Part II Order).
