MUNICIPAL CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT STUDY**

NOTICE OF STUDY COMPLETION

The County of Wellington has completed a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) Study for Salem Bridge (No. B018050) to address existing structural deficiencies. Constructed in 1952, Salem Bridge is a single span steel half-through (pony) truss structure with a concrete deck over Irvine Creek located on Woolwich Street West, in the Township of Centre Wellington, 350 m east of Wellington Road 7.

The Class EA study determined that the existing bridge has reached the end of its service life. Based on an evaluation of alternatives, a complete replacement of the structure has been identified as the preferred alternative. The study was conducted in accordance with Schedule B of the *Municipal Class Environmental Assessment* process (October 2000, as amended 2007, 2011, and 2015).

A Project File has been prepared to document the planning and decision-making process for this study. By this Notice, the Project File is being placed on the public record for a forty-five (45) day review period from and including December 10, 2018 to January 23, 2019 through the County website:

Information will be collected in accordance with the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act. With the exception of personal information, all comments will become part of the public record.

If concerns regarding this project cannot be resolved in discussions with the County of Wellington, a person or party may request the Minister of the Environment, Conservation and Parks to make an order (referred to as a Part II Order) for the project to comply with Part II of the Environmental Assessment Act which addresses Individual Environmental Assessments. As of July 1st 2018, a standardized form is to be used by anyone who believes that the environmental assessment process was incomplete, incorrect or that it failed to follow the required process. The required form can be found on the Forms Repository website (<http://www.forms.ssb.gov.on.ca/>) by searching "Part II Order" or "012-2206E (the form ID number). Once completed, the form is then to be sent to both the Minister and Director of the Environmental Assessment and Permissions Branch within the calendar day review period at the address below.
