NOTICE OF STUDY COMPLETION

The County of Wellington has completed a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) Study for Eramosa River Bridge (No. B124135) to address existing structural deficiencies. Constructed in 1953, the Eramosa River Bridge is a single span reinforced concrete rigid frame structure that carries two lanes of traffic over the Eramosa River, located on Wellington Road 124 (WR124) in the Town of Erin, 1 km east of Wellington Road 125.

The Class EA study determined that the existing bridge has reached the end of its service life. Based on an evaluation of alternatives, a complete replacement of the structure has been identified as the preferred alternative.

The study was conducted in accordance with Schedule B of the *Municipal Class Environmental Assessment* process (October 2000, as amended 2007, 2011, and 2015). A Project File has been prepared to document the planning and decision-making process for this study. By this Notice, the Project File is being placed on the public record for a thirty (30) day review period from and including **October 1, 2018** to **October 31, 2018** through the County website:
