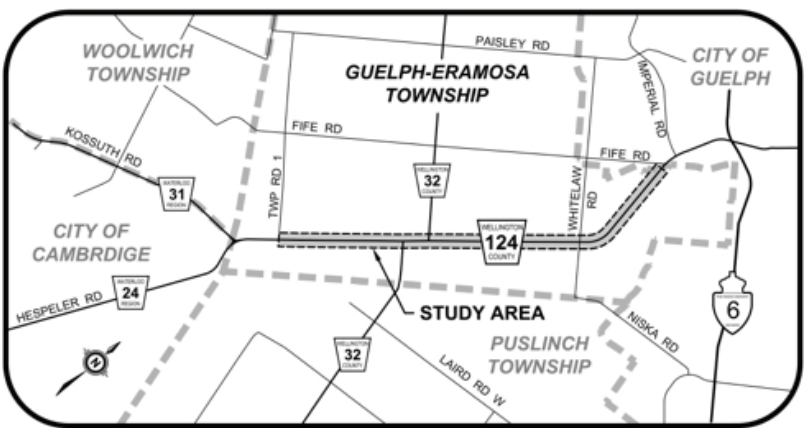

**NOTICE OF STUDY COMMENCEMENT**  
**PUBLIC COMMENT INVITED**

**The Study**

Wellington County Road 124 has experienced growing traffic congestion between Guelph Eramosa Township Road 1 and Fife Road. The County is therefore considering improvements to County Road 124 to address the congestion, road safety, intersection improvements and drainage.



**The Process**

In accordance with the requirements for Schedule C projects of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment, the Study will define the problem, identify and evaluate alternative solutions and design concepts, recommend a design, assess potential impacts and identify mitigation measures associated with the preferred design.

A key component of the study will be consultation with interested stakeholders including public agencies and Aboriginal communities. At least one Public information Centre will be held to present and review the study findings and alternatives, and discuss issues related to impacts of the design and mitigation measures. At the conclusion of the study, the EA process and findings will be documented in an Environmental Study Report (ESR) which will be made available for 30 days for public review and comment.
