NOTICE OF ONLINE PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE

The County of Wellington is conducting a Schedule B Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) Study for the Eramosa River Bridge, NO. B124135, located on Wellington Road 124 (WR124) in the Township of Erin, 1 km east of Wellington Road 125. The study will confirm and document the current structural deficiencies, address substandard elements, and identify alternative solutions, including rehabilitation and widening or replacement of the bridge, and evaluate associated environmental impacts. A key plan showing the location of the bridge site is provided on the reverse side of this notice.

Eramosa River Bridge is a single span reinforced concrete rigid frame structure that carries two lanes of traffic over the Eramosa River. Constructed in 1953, the bridge has a 15.24 m clear span and an overall deck width of 14.43 m. As part of a bridge inspection conducted in 2015, the Eramosa River Bridge was found to be in an advanced state of deterioration while some elements were identified as not meeting current standards. Corridor improvements that include the addition of a passing lane are also being implemented to accommodate projected growth in development traffic and improve safety. Therefore, this study will also examine alternatives that will allow for the addition of a passing lane on the Eramosa River Bridge. WSP has been retained by the County of Wellington to complete a Municipal Class EA Study to address these items.

Public Engagement and Consultation

An online Public Information Centre (PIC) has been arranged to allow local residents and interested members of the public an opportunity to review and comment on the alternatives under consideration, the evaluation process, and the next steps in the study. Representatives of the County of Wellington and WSP (the County's consultant) can be contacted to answer questions about the study. Display boards will be made available to the public on the County website beginning **May 30, 2018**. They can be viewed any time after this date by visiting:
