MUNICIPAL CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT STUDY

NOTICE OF ONLINE PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE NO.1

The County of Wellington is conducting a Schedule 'B' Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) Study for Salem Bridge (No. B018050), located on Woolwich Street West, in the Township of Centre Wellington, 350 m east of Wellington Road 7. The Class EA study will confirm and document the structural and functional deficiencies and identify alternative solutions, including rehabilitation or replacement of the bridge, and evaluate associated environmental impacts. A Key Plan showing the location of the bridge site is provided on the reverse side of this notice.

The Salem Bridge is a single span steel half-through (pony) truss structure with a concrete deck over Irvine Creek. The bridge has a span and roadway width of 31.7 m and 7.32 m respectively and was constructed in 1952. As part of a bridge inspection conducted in 2015, Salem Bridge, No. B018050 was found to be in an advanced state of deterioration and some functional deficiencies were identified. In addition, Salem Bridge is triple posted for the load restrictions of 18-28-35 tonnes. In an effort to remove the load-posting and address existing structural deficiencies, WSP has been retained by the County of Wellington to complete a Class EA Study for the structure. Upon completion of the study, the planning process will be documented in a Project File and made available for public review.

Public Engagement and Consultation

An online Public Information Centre (PIC) has been arranged to allow local residents and interested members of the public an opportunity to review and comment on the alternatives under consideration, the evaluation process, and the next steps in the study. Representatives of the County of Wellington and WSP (the County's consultant) can be contacted to answer questions about the study. Display boards will be made available to the public on the County website beginning Wednesday, May 30, 2018. They can be viewed any time after this date by visiting:

Residents are encouraged to submit comments by June 13, 2018. Comment sheets are available on the County's website and can be submitted via an online form or by mail, email, or fax.
