### Tree Nursery Volunteer

#### BASIC FUNCTION:

The Green Legacy Tree Nursery's primary function is to grow 160,000+ seedlings and saplings per year. The **Tree Nursery Volunteer** is utilized for supporting the propagation and maintenance of the Green Legacy Nursery Trees and maintaining a safe and educational environment for visiting volunteers and school groups.

Tasks can include: propagation, watering, and maintenance of the trees and nursery equipment. The **Tree Nursery Volunteer** will work with various numbers of volunteers, from students to seniors.

#### Training provided for all nursery tasks.

**Primary tasks** include assisting volunteers with:

- Filling containers with soil
- Transplanting trees and shrubs
- Sowing seeds in containers
- Watering and maintenance of trees and shrubs

Other tasks may include:

- Assist with private and public planting event
- Assist in seed collection
- Facility maintenance
- Assist with school groups
- Lead or supervise nature hikes
