#### **BASIC FUNCTION:**

The Green Legacy Tree Nursery's primary function is to grow 160,000+ seedlings and saplings per year. The **Tree Nursery Youth/Student Volunteer** is utilized for supporting the propagation and maintenance of the Green Legacy Nursery Trees and maintaining a safe and educational environment for visiting volunteers and school groups.

Tasks can include: propagation, watering, and maintenance of the trees and nursery equipment. The **Tree Nursery Youth/Student Volunteer** will work with various numbers of volunteers, from students to seniors.
