



KidsAbility Enhanced Support Services (ESS) therapists consult in the areas of Occupational Therapy, Physiotherapy, and Speech & Language Therapy. ESS therapists work in partnership with educators and programme staff, as well as Mental Health Consultants, and Resource Consultants to provide supportive information, strategies, ideas, and resources.

## What we do:

- General Consultation provide classroom-wide strategies to support all children in areas of accessing physical environment, play skills, and communication to ensure inclusion, and participation for all. - Child Specific Support therapists will offer time-sensitive, child specific observations to gather information related to an identified functional need/goal and provide specific targeted strategies for programme staff to support the child's needs.
- Direct Liaison Support therapists will offer child specific support to program staff for a child currently receiving therapy services in the specified discipline through KidsAbility's Early Years program.
