Background

The Housing Services Act (the “Act”) states that minimum rents are to be indexed annually using the rent increase guideline. Existing households paying less than the minimum rent are subject to a phased-in provisional minimum rent which will be increased annually.

Minimum Rents

The minimum rent will be increasing for the period **July 1, 2022 – June 30, 2023** as follows:

- The indexed minimum rent is \$133 per month.
- The provisional minimum rent is \$109 per month. The provisional minimum rent applies only to households whose rent or housing charge has remained below the previous indexed minimum rent of \$131.

The minimum rent for a single person receiving Ontario Works or Ontario Disability Support Programme (ODSP) whose RGI is calculated using the scale rate remain the same:

- Minimum rent for an Ontario Works benefit unit of one person is \$85.
- Minimum rent for an ODSP benefit unit of one person is \$109.
