SUBJECT: Training and Succession Plans

BACKGROUND

The Housing Services Act, 2011 (HSA) requires that housing providers develop the following plans:

- 1. a plan for training the staff and volunteers involved in the operation of the housing project
- 2. a succession plan for the board of directors, and
- 3. for housing co-operatives, a plan for educating members about the governance of the cooperative

DIRECTION

Housing providers will develop the required plans. The plans must be formally approved by the board of directors at a meeting of the board.

The plans must be submitted to the CMSM on or before December 31, 2015.

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APPLICATION

- Resources for the development of succession and training plans are available through the Co-operative Housing Federation (CHF), the Ontario Non-Profit Housing Association (ONPHA) and the CMSM.
- Housing providers are expected to review and update their plans as required to keep the plans current and relevant
- Any costs associated with board and staff training should be included in the annual budget.
