- Attachment: the close connection between a child and caring, supportive adults
- Emotional Regulation: recognizing, identifying and managing emotions
- Resiliency: a child's ability to withstand stress and adversity
- Temperament: the combination of a child's mental, physical and emotional traits
- Social Skills: friendships, cooperation, social independence, and social interaction
