Oversize/Overweight Permit Application

Issued Under Section 110 of the Highway Traffic Act

Provisions and Conditions

Permit is NOT Valid:

- a) on any road or highway other than roads under the jurisdiction of the County of Wellington
- b) on County of Wellington roads under construction or during load restriction periods as determined from time to time
- c) on Saturdays, Sundays and Statutory Holidays except Easter Monday and Remembrance Day when Remembrance Day falls on Monday to Friday inclusive.
- d) in congested traffic conditions when the overall width exceeds 3.05 metres (10 feet) or the overall length exceeds 24.5 metres (80 feet).
- e) from 2 hour after sunset to 2 hour before sunrise or at any other time when, due to insufficient light or unfavourable atmospheric conditions, persons and vehicles on the road are not clearly discernible at a distance of 150 metres or less.

Conditions:

- a) all conditions that are contained on the Ontario Ministry of Transportations Permit shall apply to this permit.
- b) when transporting a load in excess of 3.7 metres in width an escort proceed and follow the vehicle.
- c) A photo copy of this permit and an original of the Ontario Ministry of Transportations permit must be carried in the vehicle and produced on demand of a police officer or an officer for carrying out enforcement of the Highway Traffic Act.
- d) The permit is issued on the condition the permit holder accepts responsibility for any and all damage that may be caused to overhead wires, structures, roads, encroachments, or railway rights-of-ways.
